Go Idle Free

In conjunction with Earth Day, April 22nd, The City of Kirkland is partnering with *Sustaining America* on a campaign encouraging drivers to turn their engines off when parked for more than 10 seconds. Turning your engine off reducing fumes which can cause health problems, and protects your engine, since idling can cause build-up that can damage engine parts.
